BACKGROUND

When the Housing Authority of the County of Stanislaus first commenced in 1947 it was properly named because it had only served the Stanislaus County community. From the time of its inception, the Housing Authority has acquired seven other counties that include: Alpine, Amador, Calaveras, Inyo, Mariposa, Mono, and Tuolumne. These counties are in addition to Stanislaus, increasing the Housing Authority's geographical jurisdiction to eight (8) counties. Because of this increase, it has become necessary and appropriate to have a name that is more reflective of a larger multi-county jurisdiction. Subsequently, in 2017, the Housing Authority has been doing business as Stanislaus Regional Housing Authority to capture the "regional" aspect of a multi-county jurisdiction. In order to make this change of name official, documents need to be signed and submitted to the State of California. This resolution would authorize the Chief Executive Officer/Executive Director to take necessary action and sign necessary documents to accomplish the name change.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the Board of Commissioners approve the legal name change from the Housing Authority of the County of Stanislaus to Stanislaus Regional Housing Authority and for it to take effect immediately.

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS TO LEGALLY CHANGE THE NAME TO STANISLAUS REGIONAL HOUSING AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the County of Stanislaus desires to increase the number of affordable housing throughout the eight counties it now operates in; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the County of Stanislaus has over time since its inception increased its service area from Stanislaus County to seven additional counties that include the counties of Alpine, Amador, Calaveras, Inyo, Mariposa, Mono, Tuolumne; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the County of Stanislaus should have a name that properly reflects and describes the scope of its geographical operations; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the County of Stanislaus has been conducting business as Stanislaus Regional Housing Authority; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the County of Stanislaus, shall officially change its name to Stanislaus Regional Housing Authority; and that Resolution 19-20-38 shall take effect immediately. The Chief Executive Officer/Executive Director shall take the necessary actions and execute any and all necessary documents in order to make this name change official.
