RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Board of Commissioners approve the support of Center for Human Services and Modesto Gospel Mission.

- Staff recommends purchasing fifteen (15) Edible Extravaganza coupon books from Center for Human Services in the amount of \$100.00 each for a total of \$1,500.00. The coupon books consist of discounts to Central Valley restaurants, bakeries, and eateries. Traditionally sponsorships were provided in the form of purchasing a table at the non-profit's annual fundraiser "Edible Extravaganza", however, due to COVID-19 the fundraiser has been changed to a coupon book fundraiser this year.
- Staff recommends recognizing the invaluable volunteer service provided by participants of the Modesto Gospel Mission and is recommending support in the amount of \$5,000.00. Volunteers assisted the Housing Authority in its effort to prepare Kansas House for rehabilitation and lease up. The volunteers consisted of a team who worked diligently until the job was complete. Volunteers removed all the furniture, wall mounts, and carpets in each building. The volunteers also put in the extra effort to make sure the rooms were swept and cleaned, ready for the next step of rehabilitation. The service delivered further developed a stronger community partnership with Modesto Gospel Mission.

BACKGROUND

One of the missions of the Housing Authority is to foster partnerships in the community. As part of this mission, The Housing Authority strives to be a positive and participating collaborator in the community. The Housing Authority prides itself on working with non-profits in the community that support children, families and individuals that strengthen the community and promote self-sufficiency.

Center for Human Services is a local non-profit serving the youth and families in Stanislaus County for 50 years. Some of the programs operated by the Center for Human Services, include Pathways, Students Assistance Program, Counseling Services and more.

Modesto Gospel Mission is a local non-profit and has been serving participants for 72 years. In addition to providing meals, warm beds and a place of safety to the poor and homeless, the Mission provides life skills, employment training and assistance, along with recovery and other services.

WHEREAS, the Modesto Gospel Mission coordinated volunteers for the Housing Authority to assist with clean-up and moving furniture to prepare Kansas House for renovation; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority desires to support Modesto Gospel Mission efforts with a donation in the amount of \$5,000.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the County of Stanislaus that it will:

1. Support Edible Extravaganza with a purchase of fifteen (15) VIP packages in the amount of \$1,500.00 shall be approved, and
