

The 1612 – The Agency has procured Information Technology equipment for The 1612 Property. This includes wired and wireless networks, a VPN for Site-to-Site connectivity, upgraded server hardware, and workstation peripherals. Configuration and installation will take place ahead of the agency move-in.

YardiOne Update - The Agency successfully upgraded to YardiOne in the month of September. YardiOne adds an extra layer of security and is required for the Agency to move forward with the Rent Café Compliance package. This upgrade was necessary for the Agency to move forward with the Yardi Payment Processing Module and allows for Tenants to go through the reexam process online.

Yardi Rent Café Compliance – The Agency has been working with Yardi support to develop an Isolated Test Database dedicated to the testing of Property migrations. The Agency will migrate several properties in this environment and then test to ensure all financial functionality and data integrity remains consistent throughout the database. Once that has been confirmed, Agency Staff will undergo thorough trainings provided by Yardi Inc. for the modules that will contain migrated Properties. Once trainings are complete, migrations will take place in the live database and the Agency will move forward with the Rent Café Compliance Package project.

Security Camera Systems – In an effort to combat illegal dumping at various Agency Sites, the Agency is currently exploring options via the City of Modesto, the City of Modesto Police Department (MPD), and Agency owned systems. These systems will consist of cameras that are able to read license plates, capture movement and illegal dumping, as well as provide remote connections for streaming and downloads of video clips for submission to MPD and the City of Modesto.

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
