RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the Board of Commissioners the approval of Resolution No. 22-23-57, authorizing the write-off of \$36,253.40 tenant accounts receivable as uncollectible.

SUMMARY

The attached resolution lists the accounts to be written off. These accounts are being written off in accordance with the Stanislaus Regional Housing Authority (“Authority”) collection procedures. The amounts being written off reflect losses resulting in costs associated with move out. These tenants have left the program owing the Authority varying amounts for back rent, maintenance charges, legal fees and miscellaneous charges.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact for Farm Labor Program is \$36,253.40
