

Yardi Projects Update – The Authority has worked over the course of 2024 to streamline property portfolios. The Agency can now move forward with additional online Rent Café offerings including integrated waitlists, integrated online applications, re-examination paperwork submittal, and other services. Agency staff worked to configure and deploy a Walk in Payment System within Rent Café to offer an alternative to Money Orders.

Walker Pointe Gated Entry – The Walker Pointe property located in Hughson was completed in early July. The site received a new vehicle gate, pedestrian gate, and secure laundry room access. This system is a part of the standardized cloud-based controller that the Authority manages.

Surveillance Trailer Deployment – The Authority has placed a second surveillance trailer equipped with solar, AI cameras, and a License Plate Reader camera at the Honey Creek property in an effort to capture footage of illegal dumping. The site has recently seen a large uptick in this activity.

Network Updates – IT staff worked earlier in July to fully update and patch the wireless network infrastructure at 1612. This equipment while new, offers updates to equipment, but more importantly security updates. Staff also reconfigured certain settings to allow for better traffic flow with less potential for service interruptions.
