Vacancy is Available on the Stanislaus Regional Housing Authority Board of Commissioners

The primary goal of the Stanislaus Regional Housing Authority is to provide quality, affordable, and safe housing in Alpine, Amador, Calaveras, Inyo, Mariposa, Mono, Stanislaus and Tuolumne Counties for low income families, households, seniors, and veterans. The seven-member Housing Authority Board of Commissioners (HABOC) is the Housing Authority's governing body and includes two tenant Commissioners and 5 Representatives of the Stanislaus County Supervisorial Districts (1 per District).

There is currently a vacancy for one Supervisorial District 5 Representative Commissioner. Commissioner. This partial term ends December 31, 2025, but is eligible for reappointment for a full four-year term. Must reside in or be employed in District 5 and be at least 18 years of age.
