The September 2025 information is preliminary for the Commissioners agenda. It is subject to additional accruals and adjusting entries for the fiscal year ended 9/30/2025. Attached are the Monthly Financial Reports for the Conventional Public Housing, Farm Labor and Housing Choice Voucher Programs.

CONVENTIONAL PUBLIC HOUSING AMP #1 (Newman, Patterson and Westley)

The year to date revenues are higher than budgeted due to higher rent revenue, HUD Operating Grants, interest income, and other revenue. The total expenditures are lower than budgeted due to lower administrative expense, maintenance expense, general expense, and offset by higher utilities expense. The program had a surplus of \$35,709 through September 2025.

CONVENTIONAL PUBLIC HOUSING AMP #2 (Oakdale, Turlock, Ceres and Hughson)

The year to date revenues are higher than budgeted due to higher rent revenue, HUD Operating Grants, interest income, and other revenue. The total expenditures are lower than budgeted due to lower administrative expense, utilities expense, maintenance expense, and offset by higher general expense. The program had a surplus of \$112,953 through September 2025.

CONVENTIONAL PUBLIC HOUSING AMP #3 (Modesto)

The year to date revenues are higher than budgeted due to higher rent revenue, HUD Operating Grants, interest income and other revenue. The total expenditures are lower than budgeted due to lower administrative expense, utilities expense, offset by higher maintenance expense, and general expense. The program had a surplus of \$171,221 through September 2025.

CONVENTIONAL PUBLIC HOUSING AMP #4 (Modesto)

The year to date revenues are higher than budgeted due to higher rent revenue, interest income, other revenue, and offset by lower HUD Operating Grants. The total expenditures are lower than budgeted due to lower administrative expense, utilities expense, offset by higher general expense and maintenance expense. The program has a surplus of \$6,129 through September 2025.

CONVENTIONAL PUBLIC HOUSING AMP #5 (Modesto)

The year to date revenues are higher than budgeted due to higher rent revenue, HUD Operating Grants, Interest income and other revenue. The total expenditures are lower than budgeted due to lower administrative expense, utilities expense, maintenance expense, and general expense. The program had a surplus of \$65,383 through September 2025.

CONVENTIONAL PUBLIC HOUSING COCC (Central Office Cost Center)

The year to date revenues are lower due to lower other revenue. The total expenses are lower than budgeted due to lower administrative expense, utilities expense, maintenance expense, and general expense. The program had a surplus of \$65,383 through September 2025.

FARM LABOR

The year to date revenues are higher than budgeted due to higher other revenue, offset by lower dwelling income and interest income. The total expenditures are higher than budgeted due to higher utilities expense, offset by lower administrative expense, maintenance expense, general expense. The program had a deficit of \$38,628 through September 2025.

HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER (HCV)

The year to date revenues are lower than budgeted due to lower lease up. The total expenses are lower than budgeted due to lower administrative expense, contract expense, and offset by higher general expense. The program had a surplus of \$680,456 through the September 2025. The HCV admin reserves had an expense of \$390,588.31 to cover the HAP shortfall 2024. The admin reserve account had sufficient funds to cover this one-time expense, as required by HUD.

HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER COCC (Central Office Cost Center)

The year to date revenue is is lower than budgeted due to lower lease up. The total expenses are lower than budgeted due to lower administrative expense, general expense, and offset by higher contract costs. The program had a surplus of \$50,131 through September 2025.
